Record how many minutes you walk each day. Be sure to pick up your dog's poop!</p>	<p>The next time your parents run the sprinklers, put two cans out in the yard. Measure how much water you collect in 15 minutes. <p>Collect at least 10 small objects in your house. Predict what will float and what will sink. Then test each object in a bucket of water.</p>	<p>Make a sign to put up in your bathroom reminding people to turn off the water when they brush their teeth and take short showers. Come up with a few more ideas of your own!</p>	<p>The next time you take a shower, collect the water in a bucket as you wait for it to heat up.
