Record how many minutes you walk each day. Be sure to pick up your dog's poop!</p>	<p>Have an adult teach you the best way to wash your hands. Come up with a chant or a rap you can sing that lasts 20 seconds. Sing your song each time you wash your hands.</p>
<p>Collect at least 10 small objects in your house. Predict what will float and what will sink. Then test each object in a bucket of water.</p>	<p>Turn off the lights every time you leave your room.</p>	<p>The next time you take a shower, collect the water in a bucket as you wait for it to heat up.
