Fish, Reptiles, and Amphibians



Fish are animals that are cold-blooded. They have a backbone

- 🌊 Fish breathe with gills that take in oxygen from the water. The water carries away their carbon dioxide.
- 🌊 Fish use fins to move.
- 🌊 Fish live their lives in the water.

Reptiles like snakes, lizards, and turtles are animals that are cold-blooded. They have a backbone.

- 🌊 Reptiles have dry, scaly skin.
- 🌊 Reptiles usually lay soft eggs on land.

Amphibians like frogs and toads are animals that are cold-blooded. They have a backbone.

- 🌊 Amphibian larvae hatch from eggs. The larvae use gills to get air from water. In later stages, amphibians use lungs to breathe.
- 🌊 Amphibians have soft, moist skin.
